

## The Big Cheese Security Statement

Your safety is our priority. We are constantly reviewing our security procedures and work very closely with our partners to ensure that we have an appropriate level of security in place.

Visitors may be searched at random on entry and metal detector wands will be used. Please allow extra time to pass through security and check the list of prohibited items below. There will be a police presence on site.

Our security and stewarding teams are there for your safety.

Due to the current unprecedented security situation, it is better for everyone if you do not bring a bag at all. If you must bring a bag, it must be small (no bigger than 35cm x 40cm x 19cm).

The following items are not to be brought onto the event site: laser pens, fireworks, alcohol, glass containers, any weapon including sharp objects, illegal substances. This list is not exhaustive and security reserve the right to refuse items to be brought onto the event site that are deemed unsafe.

Management reserves the right to conduct security searches and confiscate any item which is not permitted and to eject any person refusing to a search.

## Important Event Notice

**Alcohol Policy** - There is an onsite bar and designated drinking area at the event. No Alcohol is permitted to be brought onto the Big Cheese site. Alcohol will be confiscated and destroyed on entry by security staff, police or CCBC Community Safety Wardens. Please be aware that any alcohol bought in the food halls at the event is for offsite consumption (to take home), and cannot be consumed anywhere on the event site.

**Food** - Visitors from outside of the event site are welcome to bring food onto the event site, especially if bought from local fish and chip shops etc. (We had concerns raised from the chippy on Nantgarw road that their customers were being stopped from taking food onsite and hence sales plummeted – I know this wasn't the case but just to reiterate to staff please)

**Dogs in the Music / Bar area** – we will permit dogs into the seating area outside of the big top marquee but not actually in the big top. The overall agreement is dogs are allowed to the event site in open areas but not in marquees or in the funfair due to the loud noises and crowds.

**Guide Dogs** – Permitted everywhere.
