

The Big Cheese Security Statement

Your safety is our priority. We are constantly reviewing our security procedures and work very closely with our partners to ensure that we have an appropriate level of security in place.

Visitors may be searched at random on entry that may include the use of metal detector wands. Please allow extra time to pass through security and check the list of prohibited items below.

Our security and stewarding teams are there for your safety.

Due to the current unprecedented security situation, it is better for everyone if you do not bring a bag at all. If you must bring a bag, it must be small (no bigger than 35cm x 40cm x 19cm).

The following items are not to be brought onto the event site: laser pens, fireworks, alcohol, glass containers, any weapon including sharp objects, illegal substances. This list is not exhaustive and security reserve the right to refuse items to be brought onto the event site that are deemed unsafe.

Management reserves the right to conduct security searches and confiscate any item that is not permitted and to eject any person refusing to a search.

Important Event Notice

Alcohol Policy - There is an onsite bar and a designated drinking area at the event. No Alcohol is permitted to be brought onto the Big Cheese site. Alcohol will be confiscated on entry by security staff, police or CCBC Community Safety Wardens. Please be aware that any alcohol bought in the food halls at the event is for offsite consumption (to take home), and cannot be consumed anywhere on the event site.

Food - Visitors from outside of the event site are welcome to bring food onto the event site. There are many vendors located in the town centre offering refreshments and hot food.

Dogs in the Music / Bar area – we will permit dogs into the chill out zone by the bar area. Dogs are allowed onto the event site in open areas but not in marquees, the beach area or in the funfair.

Guide Dogs – Permitted everywhere.
